MINISTER

MINISTER

In the bonds of marriage your relationship in truth will be THREEFOLD. It will be God, Daniel and Betsy. My earnest desire is that you will live out your years together keeping that truth ever before you. That THREEFOLD CORD will not quickly be broken and I believe you will have many wonderful years together keeping God at the center.

It is now 47 years later in the lives of Daniel and Betsy

PRIVATE HOSPITAL ROOM IN PACIFIC NORTHWEST - 2009

Daniel gets out of chair next to Betsy's bed and leaves her room and goes to the nurses' station. Betsy's best friend Judy shows up to visit Betsy. Betsy is coughing frequently. She's on oxygen and I-V drips.

JUDY

(kissing Betsy's forehead) Oh, my Betsy! Sorry I didn't get by yesterday. Where's Daniel?

BETSY

He went down to the Nurses' Station. He'll be back soon. (coughs)

JUDY

I'm so worried about you.

BETSY

I'll be ok, Judy. It's Daniel I'm worried about. Forty-seven years together. He's really holding on to me. Don't know if he can ever let me go.

LARGER HOSPITAL ROOM - SAME HOSPITAL

All three of Daniel and Betsy's children are keeping vigil in the same room with their Dad. Betsy's eyes have been closed for a long time. Her breathing is shallow and noisy. The children are speaking quietly with each other, not looking at their mother. Daniel's eyes are fixed on his dying wife Betsy. The wall clock shows 2AM and for a brief precious moment Daniel observes Betsy raise eyebrows dramatically over her still-closed eyes. To Daniel it looks as if a curtain was just pulled back for her that was hiding something breathtakingly beautiful.

DANIEL

(Looking towards the three children) Did you see Mom's expression?

HANNAH

No, Dad. What?

DANIEL

She just raised her eyebrows like in a surprised delight.

PAUL

Dad ... Do you think she just saw into heaven?

DANIEL

Maybe the LORD just took her spirit and she's really not here with us any more.

Daniel opens Bible and reads verses about the River of God as George, Paul and Hannah listen.

SAME HOSPITAL ROOM. CLOCK NOW READING 4AM

Two nurses arrive and make some tests and observations. One places stethescope on Betsy's chest.

NURSE

I'm sorry. No sign of life. She's passed away.

The children turn sadly to leave the room. Paul and Daniel linger and are the last to leave.

PAUL

She's with the LORD now, Dad. Sorry. That's not Mom anymore.

Paul hugs his Dad and slowly the two turn and leave.

DANIEL AND BETSY'S HOUSE

It's Sunday after church. The boys and their Dad decide to engage in emotional diversion. They get clay targets, a big box of shells and Dad's 20 guage shotgun, taking turns flinging targets skyward into the gray and drippy Northwest November sky. Hannah opens the front door to watch the action. Daniel's little Cockapoo dog MOKI bolts off unnoticed into the forest to escape the noise of the shotgun. Hannah decides to join Daniel and her brothers, when George asks,

GEORGE

Where's MOKI?

HANNAH

Oh no! I think she's gone! Maybe the gun scared her.

All three and Daniel start calling for MOKI. It gets dark early in November and there is no response. Soon nearby coyote howling penetrates the silence.

GEORGE

This is terrible. We just lost Mom yesterday and now Dad's lost the little dog he loves. How can I even face telling my daughter this all happened! And I'm to blame with the shooting.

HANNAH

And I let her escape out the front door.

PAUL

We're all involved. We just gotta find her. We need to pray.

Daniel and the three children pray in the kitchen together.

DANIEL

I'm gonna call Brock and Judy. Maybe they can help us.

GEORGE

Yeah Dad ... Brock's always been there to help you.

DANIEL

(On telephone)

Brock! We just lost MOKI. She got scared and ran off while were we shooting clay targets.

BROCK

That's what they do. They can't handle loud noises. I'll come over and help you look for her.

BROCK

(arriving)

Hey ... Do you have any favorite noise-making toy of hers?

Daniel grabs MOKI's small stuffed squeaking toy from her indoor kennel.

DANIEL

This is her very favorite, Brock.
Makes a loud squeaking noise.
(demonstrates)

BROCK

Ok. Which way did she take off?

GEORGE

I think she may have gone over the creek bridge. That's where the coyote howls were coming from too. Be awful if they got her ... She's so little.

A short while later Brock returns, soaking wet, with flashlight in hand and with a shivering and wet MOKI wrapped over and clinging to his shoulder. Everyone's eyes glisten, especially Daniel's. MOKI is passed from person to person and hugged. Hannah gets a towel from the bathroom to dry the dog.

GEORGE

Thank the LORD! He answered our prayers and Dad'll still have MOKI. We can't thank you enough, Brock!

long porch eave and he's overwhelmed to see that all the hanging plant buckets which had long since lost their flowers are now beautifully filled with Betsy's artificial flowers which had been quietly removed from inside the house that morning.

Daniel dials George's cellphone

DANIEL

George, Dad here. When did you guys get up to leave?

GEORGE

Real early, Dad. We wanted to let you sleep.

DANIEL

You made the front porch look so cheerful and beautiful. Thanks. Love my sons so much! Drive safe. Call me when you get home.

GEORGE

Love you, Dad. Come down soon. And let us know when Mom's Memorial Service will be.

DANIEL

Will do. I do need time with the family. Bye.

COLUMBIA BIBLE CHURCH

A memorial service has just concluded at the church. Abby and her friend Lisa are discussing the passing of their friend Betsy.

LISA

She was one wonderful friend, wasn't she...battled that cancer seven years!

ABBY

Had a great sense of humor, too. When she quit working last summer I realized she was failing fast.

LISA

Daniel looks so sad. They were married almost forty-eight years. Wonder how he'll cope by himself with his whole family down in San Diego.

ABBY

I know. He was so loving to her. His life revolved around her. We'll see him around town, at least for a while. We should try to cheer him up and bring that happy smile back.

LIVING ROOM OF DANIEL'S HOUSE

It is four month's after Betsy's death and Dr Ray Sterling is reviewing with Daniel the Ordination Vows he will be asking Daniel to make at next morning's Ordination Service at Columbia Bible Church.

DR STERLING

Daniel, I think since you just lost your dear wife and are now a single widower, we should leave this next one out when I read the vows tomorrow.

DANIEL

You mean the one about the wife?

DR STERLING

Yes. The one that asks you to affirm that your wife will go with you wherever the LORD leads and that she stands beside you as your willing co-laborer.

DANIEL

It will be the last celebration at JZ's house, since he will be moving to Salmon Creek. Daniel decides to walk down and give JZ a birthday card and mingle with the assembled guests. On arriving he notices Abby in her work uniform sitting next to Brad James from down the street. Abby and Daniel break into warm smiles as Daniel greets her.

DANIEL

Oh Hi, Abby. Looks like you're all ready for work.

ABBY

Yeah. Can't stay long. Gotta be at work at two-thirty today.

DANIEL

Good to see you...and Brad, too.

LISA'S BOUTIQUE STORE

It is a year after Daniel's Ordination. Abby is sitting at the counter sipping her 11 o'clock Latte before heading across the street to start her work shift. She turns to Lisa with a far-off dreamy look in her eyes.

ABBY

You know, Lisa, I've been thinking...It's been almost seven years since Marty left me for his new adventures with that woman in (MORE)

ABBY (cont'd)

Wyoming. I've really made some wrong choices in life and this internet match-making business isn't panning out. I'm not getting any younger.

LISA

Yeah, I know how you feel. But you're a beautiful woman with a beautiful heart...and you still look so young!

ABBY

Well, it's been more than a year since Daniel lost Betsy ... Do you think he might ever be a possibility? He knows she was a good friend of mine.

LISA

Oh, you might as well forget about him. I'm surprised he hasn't moved down to San Diego to be with his kids and grandkids. He probably stays buried in his computers out at his house.

ABBY

(Sighing)

Yeah, you're probably right. But ... who knows!

COLUMBIA CHOICE FOODS SUPERMARKET

Daniel has just finished picking up a few groceries. His wife Betsy's old friend Jeanette is out for the day visiting and is with him as he heads for the checkout area. Daniel looks over the checkouts and spots Abby who is just arriving back from her break taking over for her coworker Carla. The other lines are busy and she motions to Daniel.

ABBY

I just opened the register and I can check you out.

As Abby checks Daniel's groceries, Daniel is looking uncomfortable.

DANIEL

ABBY

Hi. Nice to meet you.

Abby turns back to Daniel.

ABBY

Paper or plastic.?

DANIEL

Paper, I guess. (turning to Jeanette) If you know Abby you just don't dare ask for plastic. She hates plastic!

Daniel and Jeanette leave the store. Abby's smile quickly disappears as she waits on the next customer.

LISA

ABBY

LISA

LISA

How are you doing, Daniel?

DANIEL

LISA

DANIEL

Nope. Not really. Too expensive in California. Besides, I can drive down whenever I feel like it. MOKI rides great in the car in her kennel. Hey...You know that gal Abby ... She ever been married?

LISA

Yes; to a real rotten dude who up and left her for another woman over in Wyoming. About seven years ago I think.

DANIEL

She's such an attractive lady with a super-pleasant personality. Very nice and always friendly. I know you are close to her.

LISA

Real close. The kids and I share her apartment. I consider Abby like a Mom to me. That's what I call her.

DANIEL

Let me ask you something, since you really know her. Do you think she is a Christian?

LISA

You bet she is. No doubt about it.

DANIEL

(looking very pleased)
Just curious, that's all. Abby just
seems so different and so nice.

LISA

She's a wonderful person!

COLUMBIA CHOICE FOODS SUPERMARKET

August the 4th. Abby just had her birthday on the 1st. Daniel finishes his grocery shopping and heads over to checkstand number one to have Abby check him out. He knows Abby likes to be part of old JZ's birthday celebrations.

DANIEL

Hi Abby. Did you hear about JZ's 101st birthday party over at the Senior Center in Salmon Creek?

ABBY

No. When is it?

DANIEL

It's this Saturday. Are you gonna qo?

Abby reaches over behind her Cash Register and grabs her work schedule.

ABBY

Actually, I'm off Saturday. I'd really like to go.

DANIEL

Well, I'm going. Why don't we carpool together?

ABBY

Sure. Why not!

DANIEL

How about if I pick you up at your place? What's your phone number? I can call you.

Abby hastily writes her phone number on a scrap of paper and hands it to Daniel.

ABBY

You can call my cell tomorrow. I'm on Supper Break at four-thirty, and we can figure out the time for Saturday morning.

DANIEL

Thanks!

Daniel pushes his cart with the bagged groceries over to the store's greeting card rack and begins looking for a birthday card for JZ. A few minutes later Abby comes over to the card rack. She's on her scheduled break.

ABBY

I'm on break. I need to get a card for JZ too.

Daniel and Abby have a fun time looking over cards suitable for the "Old Geezer" JZ. After picking his card, Daniel starts flipping through some Belated Birthday cards.

ABBY

Do you need a card for someone else?

DANIEL

Yeah ... Not sure what would be appropriate for my fun-loving daughter-in-law. I missed her birthday.

Daniel takes his card for JZ back over to the checkstand to pay for it and Abby shows up with a card in her hand just as he is next in line for checkout. She hands it to Daniel.

ABBY

I found this one. Might work for your daughter-in-law.

DANIEL

DANIEL'S HOUSE

DANIEL

BRAD

Good idea. Give me a jingle in the morning when you're leaving your house.

DANIEL

Will do. Take care.

DANIEL'S HOUSE

It's just after ten-thirty. Daniel phones Brad.

BRAD

Hello.

DANIEL

OK, Brad, I'm just now leaving to pick you up.

BRAD

I'm gonna have to bow out on the party. I ate a bunch of raspberries last night and they gave me bad diverticulitis. Got a lot of pain in my gut this morning.

DANIEL

That's too bad. Hope you get better soon.

BRAD

It'll go away. This hits me now and then. I just gotta watch what I eat. You guys give JZ my best and tell him I'm sorry I couldn't make it.

DANIEL

Will do. See ya.

ABBY'S APARTMENT

Daniel parks his car and knocks on sliding door of Abby's apartment. Abby is in bathroom with door open. She's almost ready to go.

ABBY

Come on in. I'm almost ready.

Abby emerges from her bathroom with an electric toothbrush buzzing away in her mouth. She looks radically different without her work uniform.

ABBY

Where's Brad? Is he waiting for us out in the car?

DANIEL

No. He had to bow out. He came down with a diverticulitis attack. Ate a lot of raspberries last night. Just the two of us going.

IN DANIEL'S CAR ENROUTE JZ'S PARTY

ABBY

So ... Do you know why I try to never miss JZ's Birthday Parties?

DANIEL

Why?

ABBY

He and I have the same birthday, only we're forty years apart.

DANIEL

Just gave away your age, Abby! Makes you sixty-one.

ABBY

Yep. You got that right.

DANIEL

I'd never guess you sixty-one!

DANIEL

Since its your birthday too, can I take you out to dinner after the party's over?

ABBY

Sure!

DANIEL

How about the Italian Gardens? - It's not far from the party.

ABBY

I love eating there. Italian food's my favorite.

DANIEL

Mine too.

ITALIAN GARDEN RESTAURANT

Daniel and Abby are halfway through the meal.

DANIEL

Hope you don't mind me asking this, but ... You just said you've been single about seven years now. You are an attractive and very young-looking woman. I'm surprised you're still single. How come?

ABBY

Well, I'm waiting for the man that GOD has for me.

DANIEL

And how are you gonna know when that's happening?

ABBY

That man will put GOD first, me second and himself last.

DANIEL

OK...

ABBY

(breaking in)

And I will put GOD first, him second and myself last.

DANIEL

A THREEFOLD CORD. Real strength. That's in the Bible. Ecclesiastes 4:12

ABBY

It's the only way I want it to be. I've made some bad choices in life and I don't want them repeated! It's gonna have to be GOD's way or I'm not going there.

DANIEL

That's a great commitment. You couldn't give a better answer.

DANIEL'S CAR - ENROUTE ABBY'S APARTMENT

DANIEL

So - what's on your agenda tomorrow?

ABBY

I'm headed out in the afternoon for my friend Josie's house. We're going over plans for our vacation in Europe.

DANIEL

When's that? Where are you going in Europe?

ABBY

Leaving next month - Labor Day weekend - heading to England, Scotland and Wales. I'll be gone for the whole month.

DANIEL

That means I won't get to see you for a full month. I'm just getting to know you! When did you decide to make this trip?

ABBY

It's been in the planning for almost three years. She and I got our tickets quite a while ago. It's all mapped out. Even the Bed 'n Breakfast places. We're gonna do the whole tour with Rail Passes.

DANIEL

Wow! You know I'll really miss you! Just getting to know you and in less than a month you'll be gone

DANIEL

Hey - I got an idea.

ABBY

What?

DANIEL

I'll be home tomorrow afternoon after church. My house is on the way to Josie's - Right?

ABBY

Yes.

DANIEL

Why don't you stop by on your way up to her place and I'll give you a tour of my house?

ABBY

Love to. Aren't you right up the street from Brad's next door to JZ's old house.

DANIEL

Same side of the street. Come up the long driveway.

ABBY

It'll probably be about three.

DANIEL

OK. I'll be home expecting you.

DANIEL'S HOUSE - SUNDAY AFTERNOON

Abby takes a long look at the picture on the wall of Daniel, Betsy and their entire family. The plaque above it reads

"All because two people fell in love". She turns to look at Daniel.

ABBY

That's a great picture. I always wanted to have a marriage and a big family like that.

DANIEL'S DAYLIGHT BASEMENT

Abby looks around - in the bedroom, bathroom and the living room.

DANIEL

Sometimes I think this would make a nice one-bedroom rental unit. Even has a ground level entrance.

ABBY

I could really live here. Would be very adequate for me. The wood stove is something I really miss at my apartment.

DANIEL'S FRONT PORCH - LATER THAT SUNDAY EVENING

Daniel is enjoying the last minutes of the nice sunset. He gets up from his rocker and goes inside to grab his portable house phone. After returning to the rocker he phones Abby.

DANIEL

Hi Abby.

ABBY

Hi.

DANIEL

Have a good planning visit with Josie?

ABBY

Yeah...I think we got everything organized.

DANIEL

You know...I was wondering if I could stop by and take you to work tomorrow.

ABBY

You can do that if you want to. I have to clock in before one-thirty.

DANIEL

OK. I'll be there early. You don't live far from work.

ABBY

Less than a mile.

DANIEL

Catch you tomorrow.

ABBY

OK.

DANIEL

Bye.

ABBY

Bye

DANIEL'S CAR - ENROUTE ABBY'S WORK

ABBY

So sweet of you to take me to work. You're ten miles out and I can even walk from my apartment.

DANIEL

Gives me more opportunity to get to know you, Abby.

ABBY

I just thought of something. How am I gonna get home for my lunch break? Not enough time without my car.

DANIEL

I'm retired. I'll just come back and pick you up.

ABBY

Another twenty-mile round trip?

DANIEL

Sure. Why not. What time's your lunch break?

ABBY

I'll have to look at my schedule to be sure, but I think it's at five today and I have a full hour.

DANIEL

Lunch...at five? That would be supper for me. Guess when you work evening shift lunch IS supper.

ABBY

Yeah. Been on evenings for almost ten years and you get used to it.

DANIEL

What are you having for supper ...excuse me, LUNCH tonight?

ABBY

I'll find something in the fridge. Might be leftovers. Probably enough for you, too, if you wanna stay and join me.

DANIEL

I'll take you up on that.

ABBY'S APARTMENT

Daniel opens door for Abby and heads for his car's trunk. He removes electric Wok and a bag of groceries he brought from home.

ABBY

Whatcha got there?

DANIEL

Oh just some food and cooking supplies.

ABBY

You didn't have to go to all that trouble.

DANIEL

Easy. Just some Stir Fry. It'll be ready in no time.

Daniel cooking Sir Fry on counter top. Abby gets out plates and silverware and sets small Bistro table.

ABBY

Smells delicious!

DANIEL

Hope you like it.

Daniel prays for the meal.

DANIEL

Yesterday you said you'd tell me more about why you wear a wig.

ABBY

(removing her wig)

So, this is what my head looks like. My two sisters and I were born like this. It's a rare disease with no health side effects. Our brothers and both parents have (MORE)

ABBY (cont'd)

normal hair. It is some rare genetic thing that only affects females.

DANIEL

Looks like you have a scar on your skull. What IS that?

ABBY

It's from my Brain Aneurism. Happened in ninety-five. The surgeon told me that only one person out of eight survives to live a normal life.

DANIEL

Wow. Incredible. God sure must have plans for you. A living miracle. I'm so glad you pulled through and are here with me!

ABBY

(replacing her wig))
Well - now that you know all about
my head - want to go with me
Wednesday to the wig shop over in
Gresham? You can help me pick the
best one for my Europe trip.

DANIEL

Ok. But...I don't think we've been together enough for me to know all about your head, but I'd love to go with you. Great time to visit in the car.

ABBY

(laughing)

Yeah and I can learn more about YOUR head.

DANIEL

Who knows...maybe my heart, too! I'll buy lunch at your favorite nearby restaurant.

ABBY

Do you like Chinese?

DANIEL

Sounds fine with me. Can we do the wig shop first and then eat after?

ABBY

If we do that you should probably grab me about ten-thirty.

DANIEL

It's a little too soon to be grabbin' you but I can pick you up then.

ABBY

You're right (laughing) But you CAN pick me up.)

DANIEL

ABBY

DANIEL

Abby is heading for her bedroom.

ABBY

I'm going to get out of these work clothes and into something more comfortable.

Abby emerges from her bedroom in a beautiful evening dress.

ABBY

Do I clean up OK?

DANIEL

OK?? That's an extreme understatement. Wow!

WIG SHOP

ABBY

So - what do ya think of this one?

DANIEL

My favorite of all the ones you tried. I like the messed-up, wind-blown look on you and the color is perfect.

ABBY

I'm going to get it. (looking in corner mirror and beckoning Daniel) I've got this patch of darker shaded skin under my shoulder blade.

DANIEL

(looking at it closely))
Probably nothing, but you better
get it checked out by a Skin doc.

ABBY

I'm not worried about it.

DANIEL

You still should check it out. I had a surface Melanoma on my cheek about ten years ago and it's a good thing I got it removed.

CHINESE RESTAURANT - TROUTDALE

Abby and Daniel are almost finished eating.

ABBY

You know that dark patch under my shoulder - maybe you're right - I should have it checked.

DANIEL

ABBY

Yes. I understand. I thought about that too. But it's OK now, you know.

DANIEL

I know, but I just wanted to share my feelings with you. Have a nice refreshing sleep.

ARRY

Goodnight, Daniel.

DANIEL

Goodnight.

DANIEL'S HOUSE

Abby has the day off. Daniel decides to phone Abby even at the risk of waking her up.

DANIEL

Mornin' Abby. Hope I didn't disturb your sleep time.

ABBY

No - I actually got up a little earlier than usual.

DANIEL

Have you ever been to Pinchot Falls?

ABBY

No. Never heard of them. Are they around here?

DANIEL

About seven miles up the Forest Road from my house.

ABBY

Really? Lived here all my life and never even heard of them.

DANIEL

Come on by and we'll go on up. They are spectacular with triple cataracts.

ABBY

Love to. After lunch?

DANIEL

Yeah, but come on out sooner and I'll fix us lunch.

ABBY

It'll be about an hour.

DANIEL

OK. See you soon. Bye.

PINCHOT FALLS

Daniel takes Abby by the hand to lead her down from the road on the narrow forest trail to the Falls. It is a beautiful winding trail through giant Douglas Fir trees. DANIEL

Yeah. You really know how to get to me!

RYE, UNITED KINGDOM - A FEW DAYS BEFORE ABBY'S FLIGHT HOME

Abby is walking down a gravel path with Josie's stuff towards their Bed and Breakfast place while her friend Josie has gone on ahead to the restaurant to wait for Abby for dinner. Up ahead Abby spots a small shiny object lying in the gravel. She reaches down and picks it up. It is a beautiful silver ring wound into three strands joined together in unity. ABBY

DANIEL

ABBY

DANIEL

DANIEL

ABBY

DANIEL

DANIEL

Well, in about six weeks I'll be headed down to San Diego for Thanksgiving and Christmas. Not sure I can go through being without you again.

ABBY

My son Jim works for the Airline and I can fly free on my days off. That's if you could find me a place to stay.

DANIEL

Really? That'd be great! I think Hannah would let you stay at her place. Give you a chance to meet my family.

HANNAH'S HOUSE

Daniel is removing Abby's overnight bag from trunk in front of Hannah's house.

DANIEL

It's great how you can fly for nothing. Third time down now and this is helping me survive.

ABBY

You survive? You mean US!

DANIEL

I'll put your bag in Jerry's room and we'll hang out on the porch til Hannah gets home.

ABBY

Where's Ron and the boys?

DANIEL

They've got sports practice this afternoon. Ron'll be home about the same time as Hannah.

JOSH'S BEDROOM

Abby is sleeping in the first morning at Hannah's house. Her wig is hanging on the bedpost. Half awake, she sees her bedroom door open a crack. DANIEL

Daniel and Abby, clad in their pajamas, tiptoe downstairs and quietly open the front door of Hannah's house.

ABBY

the one with the big inflated Santa and the Snowman.

DANIEL

I think you're right. Bet they forgot to turn off the sound at bedtime. I'll go across and see if I can find the sound switch.

ABBY

Got slippers by your bed?

DANIEL

Yeah - should've worn them.

Abby returns with Daniel's slippers. Daniel puts them on and starts across the street. Worriedly, he tiptoes gingerly across the blacktop street.

SAN DIEGO RESIDENTIAL STREET

ABBY

Shh! Real quiet. You'll actually be trespassing.

Daniel begins exploring the neighbor's complex Christmas display - a tangled array of wires, switches and power strips. Abby is anxiously keeping her eye on Daniel. Exasperated he begins turning off switches and lights start going out. The music continues. He pulls another plug from a

socket and the music abruptly stops. Suddenly, Santa and the Snowman collapse into heaps of uninflated vinyl. Daniel flees quickly back across the street to Abby.

DANIEL

DANIEL

Remember last night's Christmas party - when Hannah gave everyone their own plastic cup with a Christmas character's name?

ABBY

What was the name was on yours?

DANIEL

SCROOGE! Can you believe it! SCROOGE! And I'm the neighborhood SCROOGE! I just killed Santa and Frosty and left everyone in the dark.

Abby and Daniel laugh again and finally quiet down and tiptoe back upstairs to their bedrooms.

DOCTOR'S OFFICE

Daniel is in Dr Smith's office and just got a skin biopsy report. He phones Abby.

DANIEL

Hi, Honey.

ABBY

Hi. Where are you?

DANIEL

At Dr Smith's. Just went over biopsy report. Turns out that spot on my nose WAS cancer. Good news is that it's what they call "IN-SITU" which means it's just on the surface and hasn't gone internal.

ABBY

Oh...That's a great relief. So - what's the next step?

DANIEL

Outpatient surgery. They'll need to graft skin from behind my ear to rebuild the area taken out.

ABBY

Wow! Who's gonna do it?

DANIEL

I could have Dr Solomon do it up home.

ABBY

No! I think we should ask Dr Smith to do it. He's a top Plastic Surgeon.

DANIEL

I think you're right, but I'd have to make another long trip down here.

ABBY

We should just fly. I want to be with you. Jim might be able to get you a Buddy Pass.

DANIEL

That'd sure be easier than a twenty-four hundred mile round trip in the car. No fun going over the Siskiyou Summit this time of year!

ABBY

Are you leaving to head north tomorrow or Friday?

DANIEL

ABBY

What?

DANIEL

ABBY

I'm actually off three days with the trade I made. Fun! We could do a motel Christmas in the morning before checkout.

DANIEL

I'll try to get reservations. What time do you arrive in San Diego?

ABBY

Get's in at ten-fifteen. Flight 623.

DANIEL

Super. I'll be all packed and pick you up at ground level. We'll be able to beat LA traffic. Safe travels, Honey!

ABBY

See you soon.

DANIEL

Bye. Call me from Sacramento, OK?

ABBY

I will. Bye.

DANIEL

Bye, Honey.

SACRAMENTO AIRPORT

ABBY

I'm here. Through flight so I can't easily get kicked off.

DANIEL

Just a couple of hours and we'll be together, Honey.

ABBY

I know!

DANIEL

Since you're off three days, I went ahead and made life easier for us driving home.

ABBY

What'd you do?

DANIEL

Friends in Mt Shasta City. Wanted you to meet them. They have a farmhouse with lots of room. We're staying there tomorrow night. Weather's supposed to be better over the Siskiyous.

ABBY

DANIEL

ABBY (cont'd)

can't believe it. We drove way out here right past the airport and forgot to get my car at the Parking Lot!

DANIEL

(laughing)

Yup. We forgot it. Good thing you thought about it before the Falls or we'd be going all the way to the Dam before we could go back and get it! Now I'm bummed. Have to drive back home all by my lonesome self and not see you til tomorrow.

ABBY

Me too. We'll just have use our cell phones to stay connected.

DANIEL'S HOUSE - WRITING/SPELLING

Abby is at Daniel's house on her day off and they are each occupying their recliners. Daniel is on his laptop and Abby is using Daniel's netbook writing an email to a friend. She has a doubt about the spelling of a word and asks Daniel for the correct spelling.

ABBY

Getting Daniel's

DANIEL

ABBY

You're not much help, but you're sure sweet.

DANIEL'S CAR LEAVING CASCADE SHOPPING CENTER

DANIEL

Remember how we talked about me making a formal marriage proposal to you soon?

ABBY

Yup. What are you thinking?

DANIEL

Well, your parents have already passed on and I think it would be appropriate for me to have someone give me permission to ask for your hand in marriage.

ABBY

You know my son Jim might think it unusual, but he knows you fairly well by now and you could ask him.

DANIEL

OK. I'm gonna try to get him on the phone right now and ask him.

Daniel's hands-free phone rings from the dashboard.

JIM

DANIEL

You're on the speaker with me and Mom, and I have an important question for you.

JIM

DANIEL

JIM

DANIEL

ABBY

HANNAH

I don't know, but I'll do some asking of the women.

ABBY

(looking at SALES WOMAN)
How about if you put aside the
three dresses I looked at. My son
is flying in today and I want him
to come back and get his opinion.

SALES WOMAN

I can do that.

Abby has gone back to Hannah's house and picked up her son Josh. She and Josh drive to the airport, pick up Jim, and return to the Bridal Shop.

SALES WOMAN

Hi Abby. This must be your son Jim. Hi, Jim. Whose the handsome young man you brought along with him?

ABBY

This handsome young man is Hannah's oldest son Josh. She couldn't come back with us. She had to attend a parent-teacher conference with his younger brother.

ABBY

PASTOR RON

PASTOR RON

DAVE

(speaking very loudly))
GREAT GRACE! ... GREAT GRACE! ...
(more loudly) GREAT GRACE!

DANIEL

ABBY

ABBY

DANIEL

Honey...I just had an idea about temporary living in Prescott.

ABBY

What?

DANIEL

DANIEL

Yeah...especially if it's furnished.

ABBY

Where you gonna look?

DANIEL

ABBY

What'll we do?

DANIEL

I'm going to do things in reverse.

ABBY

What d'ya mean?

DANIEL

I'll try posting a wanted ad on Prescott's Craig's List. Who knows?

ABBY

Worth a try. Read it to me before you post it, please.

DANIEL

Sure.

A short while later.

DANIEL

Honey. Here it is. Under Apartments Wanted. "Couple moving to Prescott area. Have been looking for RV spot while house-hunting, but none available. Considering alternative of month-to-month small apartment rental. 509-427-7999" and I attached a nice picture of us, too?

ABBY

Why'd you do that?

DANIEL

ABBY

(rolling her eyes)

DANIEL
